No one will tell you shhh! here.

It has been said by physicians that EIRMC's Medical Library is a vital link for them here at the hospital. It gives them access to surveys and journal articles that they would otherwise not have the time or resources to keep up with Most physicians subscribe to a handful of journals and publications within their field of practice, but there is so much more out there on the periphery that may be of note and just doesn't have a good way of making it onto your radar.

That's where Kathy Fatkin comes in. As EIRMC's distinguished member of the Academy of Health Information Professionals (certification from the Medical Library Association),

daily in support of evidencebased healthcare practices. A published author herself, she says that not only does EIRMC have their own subscriptions to over 80 journals, many publications and both Medline and CINAHL databases, but she is able to get copies of articles through loans and sharing programs with other medical libraries. So don't run out and buy a personal subscription to Ovid or the Lippencott journals, she can get that for you, and more!

Kathy says that often at 8am she opens her email to see requests from physicians during the late hours of the night and terribly regrets that Continued inside

she can't have that article you wanted by 3am (the twinkle in her eye belies her seriousness), but she can definitely deliver on almost everything within 24 hours.

One of the proactive ways Kathy helps physicians is through her Current Awareness Program. As new journals arrive, she photocopies the table of contents and delivers them to your mailbox. This way, physicians can quickly note articles of interest that they may not have been aware of otherwise, and can then request a copy of the article. The service is available just for the asking.

The most valuable aspect of the medical library is Kathy's expertise in searching databases. Think back for a moment to medical school and recall the countless hours of fruitless searches.

Kathy can help with that. She has extensive training in setting up highly-refined, focused queries which are rarely limited to just one database. The benefit to physicians is the best, most up-to-date articles to support them in their goal of providing the best medical care.

To discover how EIRMC's Medical Library can connect you with information you need, go to the *Intranet* and select *Clinical Research* — *E-library* from the left nav bar. A menu will pop up with a long list of resources with the very best one at the top — *Ask a Librarian*.
